VINEYARD

Morro View vineyard is located 5 miles from the Pacific Ocean in the Edna Valley. The vineyard is named for its view of the Seven Sisters—an iconic chain of volcanic peaks stretching northwest towards Morro Rock. The vineyard was planted in 2009 and includes 4 acres of organic Grenache grown on Tierra Loam soils.

WINEMAKING

At the winery, the fruit was hand-sorted and vinified with 15% whole-cluster. Prior to fermentation, the wine was gently foot-tred during a three-day cold soak. The wine fermented spontaneously with native yeast then pressed off and aged in neutral French oak barrels for 10 months. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of black cherry kirsch, dried rose petals, sage and fresh fennel on the nose. The palate is met with acidity and finished with a soft grip of tannin.
